with this message, we would like to update you about the "8th Liquid Matter Conference", which will be held in Wien, Austria, from September 6 to 10, 2011, thereby continuing a series of conferences started in 1990 in Lyon. The meeting is organized jointly by the Liquids Section of the Condensed Matter Division of the European Physical Society, the Universitaet Wien, and the Technische Universitaet Wien.

The aim of the conference is to bring together scientists working on the liquid state of matter and on closely related topics, such as soft matter and biophysics. Thus the rapidly growing field covered by this series of conferences includes the physics, chemistry, biology, and chemical engineering of liquid matter as well as several areas of applied research.

We invite you to submit contributions to any of the ten symposia subject areas, specified on the webpage; the deadline for abstract submission is April 15, 2011. Contributions must be submitted through the conference webpage. In case you prefer an oral presentation you should state this explicitly in the menu when submitting the abstract. The International Program Committee decides on the acceptance of contributions and will select oral contributions for the different topics. Notification about the acceptance of contributions will be sent out by May 31, 2011.
